Volunteer Job Opportunities

1. **“Parents Who Host, Lose the Most” campaign** - (minimal time commitment, adult/teen – throughout the year): This countywide campaign seeks to promote community awareness of Virginia underage drinking laws and the penalties for violating the law through distribution of fact cards and posters throughout the community. Volunteers are needed to distribute fact cards and posters to local organizations (churches, businesses, swim clubs, scout troops, civic groups, MYA, libraries).
2. **Community Café** (minimal to medium time commitment, adult/teen – Autumn 2009): Volunteers are needed to help organize a community event to create awareness of underage drinking and promote methods to reduce the prevalence of underage drinking by teens in our community. Assistance is needed with invitations, table leaders, refreshments, set-up and decorations.
3. **Project Sticker Shock** – (minimal time commitment, adult/teen – late winter 2009/early spring 2010). This countywide campaign is coordinated with the Virginia ABC, law enforcement and FCPS to promote adult awareness of underage drinking laws by placing “stop sign” stickers on alcoholic beverage containers. Adults and teens are needed to place stickers on containers. This is a one day event (less than half a day).
4. **Prescription Drug Disposal Day** (minimal time commitment, adult/teen – October 2009). This countywide event is being coordinated with Fairfax-Falls Church Community Services Board to provide a means for proper disposal of unused, expired prescription drugs. Volunteers are needed to help publicize the event in our community and distribute information at the disposal site.

5. **Community Awareness Programs** (minimal time commitment, adult – throughout the year). Volunteers are needed to organize community awareness programs and assist with publicity.
6. **Middle School Forum and 6th Grade Ethics Days** (minimal time commitment, adult). Volunteers are needed to assist with set up and serving lunch at these events. Table leaders are needed to facilitate discussions at 6th grade ethics days. These are one day events (3 – 6 hour time commitment).
7. **Public Service Announcements** – (minimal time commitment, adult/teen, throughout the year). Volunteers are needed to help with preparing PSAs that create awareness of underage drinking and substance use in our community.
8. **Newspaper articles** – (minimal time commitment, adult, throughout the year). Volunteers are need to write articles and letters to the editor about underage drinking, substance use and other issues affecting teens in our community.
